Privacy Notice

The Place is committed to complying with the terms of the General Data Protection Regulation which came into force on 25th May 2018, and to the responsible and secure use of your personal data. The purpose of this statement is to let you know what personal information The Place collects and holds, why we collect this data, how long it is kept and your rights over your personal data. The Place is not required to be registered with the Information Commissioner's Office

Information about you

We collect personal information from you if you and your child/ren attend our service. We ask families to voluntarily register with our service. This information includes: name, date of birth, contact details such as phone number, address and email address, relationship status, children's details, photo consent, health information, next of kin emergency contact and other relevant personal information. We collect anonymised data on ethnicity for monitoring purposes. We will review all personal information held by the service each year. Unless there is a legal requirement for us to keep your information, it will be deleted after our annual review of data if you have not used our services for a year at that point.

When you enquire about courses, workshops, talks, fundraising events or volunteering at The Place we ask for contact details and relevant personal information from you that is needed to answer your enquiries and to keep you informed about upcoming events that may be of interest to you. This data is stored securely for as long as you agree to be kept informed of our activities and your child/ren are under 5 years of age.

Our use of this information

We will use your personal data to continue to give you information about our service i.e. inform you of upcoming events and courses, inform you of any cancellation / changes to sessions, ensure your safety and well-being when accessing the service, monitor the use of the service, and for producing anonymised data for grant funding applications. We will not share your personal details with any other person or organisation without your knowledge and permission unless there is a child or adult safeguarding issue, other legal requirement or health and safety issue.

Security

In order to ensure that your information is used appropriately and that your privacy is respected, we will:-

• take steps to ensure that your information is kept as safe as possible. All attendance data will be stored on a secure database and paper registration forms in a locked cabinet. We will endeavour to keep your information accurate and up to date.

• Only those staff and volunteers who need to do so will access your personal information.

Your rights over your personal data

Data portability You have the right to ask for a copy all information held by us that you have provided and for this to be transferred to another controller.
